Membership Renewal

1 Your membership is due for renewal on 1 July 2023.

- (a) To continue your membership, you must renew your membership before 31 October 2023, or before then if you wish to participate in any Club or SLSA activity, whether it be attending the AGM, taking on a position on the Committee, training for your SRC or Bronze Medallion, coaching, or training for competition.
- (b) Members are advised that after 1 July 2023, they are not covered by Personal Accident Insurance available to SLSA members whilst participating in Club or SLSA activities, until membership renewal has been completed and fees paid.

2 Renew your membership on line through the SLSA Members Portal.

- (a) As explained on the previous page, members can renew their membership and pay membership fees at the same time through the SLSA Members Portal - go to <https://members.sls.com.au> and follow the prompts.
- (b) If you have not used the Member Portal before, you will need to set up an account. The prompts will ask you to enter your name, date of birth, and either your email address or mobile phone number.
Note - the Member Portal uses the email or mobile phone number that was recorded when you renewed your membership during 2022; thus if you have changed your email or mobile phone in the past 12 months, you may not be able to gain access. In this case, email or telephone the Club Treasurer. treasurer@stanwellparksurfclub.com or mobile 0418478116 for assistance.
- (c) If you already have an account, and have difficulty logging on using your email or mobile phone number, email or send a text to the Club Treasurer for assistance.
- (d) If you are under 18 years of age when renewing your membership, your parent or guardian will need to endorse your on-line application.
- (e) After renewing your membership, you will also need to pay your membership fees. A link in the Member Portal will direct you to the SLSA Payment Facility, or you can access the Payment Facility direct by visiting <http://pay.slsa.com.au>
- (f) Alternatively you can pay your membership fees by internet banking direct to the Club bank account, BSB 062164, Account Number 00905331, Bank Account name - Helensburgh-Stanwell Park SLSC. Add your surname and the word "fees" as reference.
- (g) Within 7 days of paying your membership fees (by either method as described in 2(f) or 2(g), you should receive by email a receipt from Helensburgh-Stanwell Park SLSC; if you do not receive this receipt, please email treasurer@stanwellparksurfclub.com and request confirmation that your payment has been received.

3 Renew membership by postal mail.

- (a) If you do not have internet access to complete on-line renewal, please contact the Club Treasurer by email or telephone (refer details in 2(b) above), and request a pre-filled membership renewal form be either posted, emailed or faxed to you. Once you have signed the form, it can be returned by either post, email or fax.
- (b) Your membership fees can be paid by cheque or money order and posted to Helensburgh-Stanwell Park SLSC, Post Office Box 111, Helensburgh NSW 2508, by direct deposit into the Club bank account (refer 2(f) above), or through the SLSA Payment Facility by visiting <http://pay.slsa.com.au>
