Minimum Requirements for Patrols

(per Life Saving Agreement 2020-2023)

- Approved and inspected equipment as outlined in the Standard Operating Procedures
- 3 x Volunteer Bronze Medallion qualified patrol members

includina

- 1 x Proficient ARTC
- 1 x Basic Beach Management
- 1 x Proficient IRB Driver 1 x Proficient IRB Crew
- Saturday Patrols will require a minimum of 2 x Bronze Medallion Holders, an ATV and radio who will undertake, in liason with the Council Lifeguards on Duty, roving patrols along the Standard Roving Patrol Area. An IRB is not required.
- Exemptions Nil

Maximum of 6 Patrol Members per patrol (Expired 08/10/2021)

No Patrol Members under 16 Years, due to this age not being able to be vaccinated at this time (Expired 08/10/2021)

All Day Patrols to prevent cross-over of patrol members (Expired 08/10/2021)

Scan QR Code on arrival to club/patrol trailer

Masks MUST be worn while on patrol, except when performing a rescue or while in the water

Patrol Members are NOT to police/enforce Social Distancing, Mask Wearing or any of the Public Health Orders.

A public exclusion zone will be setup around the Patrol Trailer/Tent

- If you are uncomfortable with patrolling during the COVID pandemic, please discuss with your patrol captain

This season the club has 7 patrols on Stanwell Park Beach, with an average of 10 members in each patrol.

To ensure the smooth running of patrols - Arrive to your patrol on-time

- the SLSA Patrol Operations APP will be used to sign you on and off patrol, it is essential that you also sign the paper patrol log as a record of your patrol attendance - Wear your full Patrol Uniform (Shorts, Shirt, and Patrol Hat).
- If you go for a swim, board paddle or surf you must be wearing your Patrol Hat (for visibility)
- Participate in the patrol.
- Make sure you arrange a swap if you are unable to make your rostered patrol.
- If you have problems finding a swap, try the Active Reserve members.
- Patrol Members are encouraged to use every piece of patrol equipment everytime they are on patrol. Builds confidence and familiarity with the equipment
- There are cans of soft drink and bottles of water in the Patrol Room fridge for Patrol members to have whilst on patrol. These are provided by the club.
